The Peterborough Symphony Orchestra and Market Hall Performing Arts Centre join forces again this year to present an afternoon of musical and culinary delights to ticket-holders at the 2004 installation of their Partners Play series entitled: “Sweets for the Senses”. Beginning at **2:30pm** on **Sunday, September 19** at **Market Hall**, members of the orchestra will recombine in various Classical chamber music groups in the order of quintets, trios, duets and solos for wind and string instruments while audience members indulge in sumptuous desserts and coffees.

“This is a **natural partnership** for us,” comments the symphony’s event organizer, Tori Owen: “Market Hall is our rehearsal venue and a great space for chamber music. City orchestras around the world offer Chamber music programs to their audience, and as the PSO grows and develops we too wish to serve our city’s culture as other cities do.”

The music program for the afternoon will span the Classical eras and include such delights as Mozart’s **Marriage of Figaro** overture arranged for woodwind quintet, and excerpts from **J. S. Bach**’s Cello suites.
